



4. Work with members of the MMP team to locate hard to find individuals as necessary. Accurately document, update and maintain all tracking methods including outcomes in CDC tracking database.
5. Maintain a solid working knowledge of current and emerging HIV counseling and testing techniques, scientific research, developing medical treatments, harm reduction and prevention alternatives.
6. Knowledge of in-State, out-of-State and national resources; and provide medical and social services referrals to all participants; including making initial medical or other ancillary services appointments as necessary.
7. Participate in required conference calls, trainings and meetings sponsored by the CDC, New Jersey Department of Health and NJCRI.
