Provide assessments and a warm, compassionate, therapeutic experience which includes psychoeducation as well as individual and group therapy sessions. We use various approaches to treat addiction, i.e., evidence-based Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Motivational Interviewing Therapy (MI) to address possible ambivalence for treatment and to build decision making skills.

## ECI Empowered Communities Initiative: Vershay Lawrence BA ext.#303
